
## Health & Wellbeing

#### Numeracy

Primary 2/1 will be building upon their learning of numbers, place value and counting as we focus on addition and subtraction skills. As well as using practical resources and active games, we will be using mental maths strategies to share different ways of making numbers.

In addition, we will be using money to identify different coins and using combinations of different coins to total given amounts.

#### French



This term we will be learning numbers in French in order to share our age with one another. In addition, we will be researching Christmas celebrations in France.

#### Expressive Arts



This term our expressive arts will be taught on a Tuesday afternoon by Miss Graham. Primary 2/1 will use paint to experiment with colour mixing and create pictures. Our music and drama lessons will focus mainly around our preparation for the school Nativity performance.
